Digital Workflow in Cranio-Maxillo-Facial Surgery

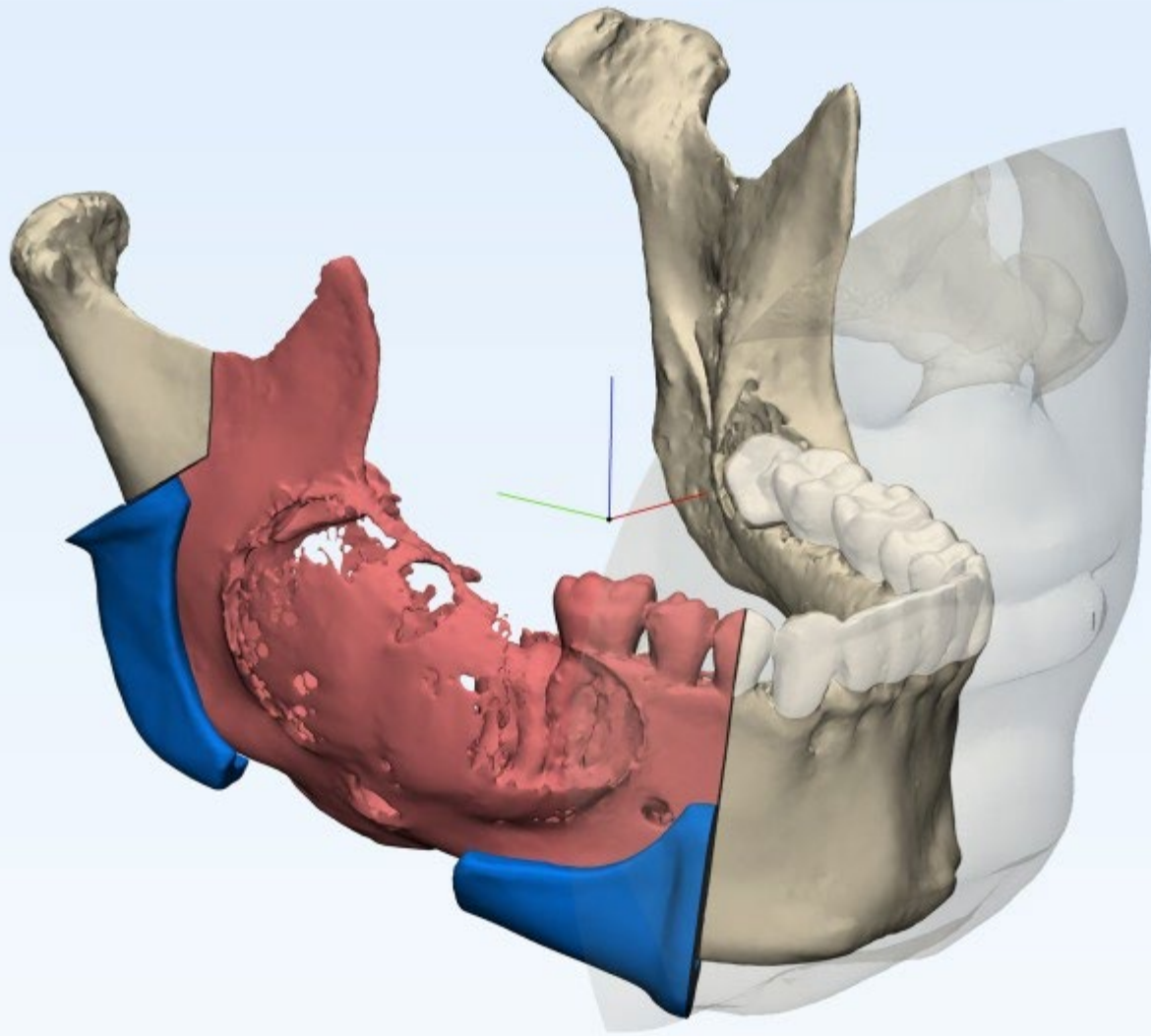

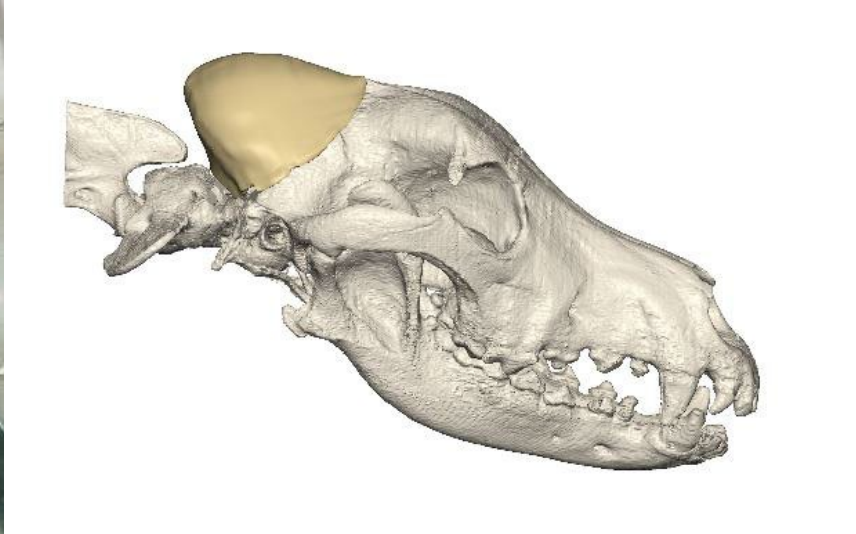
